	WHAT TO DO IN GENERAL:
You should/ <del>shouldn't</del>	be mentally prepared.
You should/ <del>shouldn't</del>	help protect others.
You should/ <del>shouldn't</del>	report bear incidents to a ranger.
You <del>should</del> /shouldn't	get close to bears.
	IF YOU SEE A BLACK BEAR:
You <del>should</del> /shouldn't	play dead.
You should/ <del>shouldn't</del>	try to escape.
You should/ <del>shouldn't</del>	fight back if you can't escape.

### **GUIDELINES IN CASE OF AN ENCOUNTER WITH A BEAR**

	IF YOU SEE A BROWN BEAR:
You should/ <del>shouldn't</del>	leave your pack on.
You should/ <del>shouldn't</del>	play dead.
You should/ <del>shouldn't</del>	lay flat on your stomach.
You <del>should</del> /shouldn't	move.
You should/ <del>shouldn't</del>	wait until the bear goes away.
You <del>should</del> /shouldn't	fight back.
You should/ <del>shouldn't</del>	fight back only if the attack continues.
