

### PRE-LISTENING ACTIVITY

#### ROLE-PLAY CARDS: MAKING SUGGESTIONS AND INVITATIONS

Divide students into pairs. Give each student a role-play card with a specific situation.

In their pairs, students have to create conversations following the prompts written on their cards.

They have to accept or refuse the invitation giving suitable reasons.

##### STUDENT A

- Invite your friend to watch a football match on TV next Thursday.
- Accept the suggestion.  
Suggest a film to watch.  
Arrange a time.
- Agree on the meeting place.

##### STUDENT B

- Refuse the invitation because you don't like football; suggest going to the cinema instead.
- Agree on the time and suggest a meeting place.

##### STUDENT B

- Suggest organising a surprise party for your friend Tom next Saturday.
- Agree on the place. Suggest a time.
- Agree and suggest things you can bring to the party.

##### STUDENT A

- You like the idea. Suggest a place where you can organise the party.
- Agree on the time and suggest inviting other people.
- Agree and suggest activities to do at the party.
