#### DEVIL'S ADVOCATE

#### THREE-WAY ROLE PLAY

##### INSTRUCTIONS

- Put students into groups of three, seated in a triangle.
- Label them **A**, **B**, **C**.
- Tell students that **A** and **B** are going to argue opposite points of view. **C** is going to listen to their arguments and then come to a decision based on them.
- Tell **A** and **B** that they must defend their role's point of view and not necessarily what they actually think.
- After the discussion feedback from **C** in each group, backing up their choice with arguments their classmate used to convince them.
- Repeat but switching roles and situation, so that **A** and **C** argue and **B** listens, then **B** and **C** argue and **A** listens.

##### ROLE PLAY 1

**A** – CONVINCING **C** TO CONTINUE TO GO TO SCHOOL AND SET HIM/HERSELF OBJECTIVES TO GET THE MOST OUT OF SCHOOLING

**B** – CONVINCING **C** TO LEAVE SCHOOL AS IT IS A TOTAL WASTE OF TIME AND ENERGY, WHEN HE \ SHE COULD BE DOING THINGS HE \ SHE REALLY WANTS TO DO IN LIFE

##### ROLE PLAY 2

**A** – CONVINCING **B** TO CHEAT AND COPY HIS \ HER WAY THROUGH SCHOOL, AS IT IS NOT IMPORTANT WHAT YOU LEARN, BUT THAT YOU GET THE QUALIFICATION

**C** – CONVINCING **B** NOT TO COPY OR CHEAT, AS HARD WORK AND RESULTS LEAD TO TRUE FULFILLMENT AND SUCCESS IN LIFE

##### ROLE PLAY 3

**B** – CONVINCING **A** TO GET OUT OF BED ON MONDAY MORNING, GIVING HIM \ HER GOOD REASONS WHY

**C** – CONVINCING **A** TO STAY IN BED ON MONDAY MORNING AND NOT TO GO TO SCHOOL, GIVING GOOD REASONS WHY
