### ZOOMING IN ON US EDUCATIONAL SYSTEM

**A college student is also called undergraduate or undergrad for short.**

**Pre-K means pre-Kindergarten and is school for 3-4 years olds.**

**K-12 refers to the complete school career from Kindergarten to Grade 12. Kindergarten is usually part of Elementary School.**

**College is the first level of University studies which leads to the Bachelor's Degree (4 years).**

**University in the US also offers second level (Graduate school) or third level degrees (Phd).**

**High school students and College students are nicknamed freshmen, sophomores, juniors and seniors according to their year of school.**
